

If you have ever been to a church business meeting, just imagine it with 5,000 participants. For me the most exciting part was the commissioning of 35 new missionaries. Half of them were introduced without their last names and in the dark so we couldn't see their faces. The reason was that they are going to countries that do not welcome Christian missionaries. We have to be careful not to cause unnecessary problems for them in their future ministries, wherever it is that they are being sent. We must continually bathe them in prayer.

Another exciting part was the seminary reports. We have six Southern Baptist seminaries that are thoroughly conservative and on fire for the Lord. There are a record number of students now training for the Lord's work; over 20,000!!!! That is the hope for the future and an answer to the prayers of God's people. There are so many good things happening in our denomination, now the largest and most ethnically diverse in the nation. We have over 47,000 churches and 16 million members! That is 1 in every 20 Americans, or 5% of the population.

In the next few weeks of summer I know many of you will be taking vacations, and I hope you are able to relax and enjoy the time away. Perhaps you will be able to worship the Lord in another church, with other believers. In New Mexico I was able to fellowship at the First Baptist Church of Bernallilo, with some fellow believers that knew my wife's family when they lived there over 50 years ago. Janet's (and her sister Nancy Hudler) father, Bill Muller, was a bi-vocational Southern Baptist pastor and helped establish a church in that town. The picture in their baptistery had been painted by their mother Betty and is still very beautiful. (continued on page 4)
