ear church family, Greetings in the precious name of our Lord, Jesus Christ. These last few months, I have been examining our core beliefs in a sermon series I call "Back to the Basics." On July 16 we began by taking a close look at our church's mission purpose statement in my sermon, "Why Are We Here?"

"The purpose of this church is to cultivate a visible, unified, community of committed believers in the Lord Jesus Christ A WORD through the proclamation of the Word of God in the power FROM THE PASTOR of the Holy Spirit so that; souls may be saved; saints be edified in the Christian faith and prepared for the service of

our Lord; and people everywhere may receive the tidings of God's grace as seen in the shed blood of Calvary—to the ultimate end that God will be glorified (Matthew 28: 19-20; Acts 1:8; Ephesians 4: 12:13).

We must all be working together to these ends. Everything that we do and all of the resources we expend must be in line with these purposes. If it is not, then we need to rethink and change what we are doing or stop doing it. I believe God is pleased when we are careful in these ways. This is the reason, for instance, that we don't conduct bazaars and bake sales, or raffles and bingo.

The next number of sermons looked in depth at our church's articles of faith. We began with the foundational belief in the Bible as the inspired, inerrant Word of God. It is interesting that this even comes before what we believe about God. The reason for that is because if we don't have a reliable source of revelation from God; we can't be sure of anything else.

I spent a number of sermons on our beliefs regarding the trinity. Simply stated, "We believe that there are three persons in the Godhead, but that they are one in substance." I encourage you to go to our church's website (fbcne.org) and listen to any of these sermons you may have missed or want to hear again. We have even included the power point presentations. I especially encourage you to listen to the sermons, "Jesus is Truly God" (June 4, 18, 25). Every Christian should be able to give an answer to anyone who asks concerning the hope that we have (1 Peter 3:15). and it is still available at our free literature table in the education wing. Those three reasons are...

- 1. The names of Christ
- 2. The works done by Jesus
- 3. The attributes accorded to Jesus

Also included are the appropriate scripture texts to back up each point.

Most recently we looked at Salvation, the Security of the Believer, The Devil, Miracles, and The Physical Creation. I will concluding be with examination of The Family.
