Let me encourage you to help if you can, but please pray. This endeavor has become what may well be the greatest evangelistic missionary outreach in the history of Christiandom. Over 168 million shoe boxes have been



shared with boys and girls from over 100 countries! An estimated 8.9 million children have trusted Christ as their personal Savior after hearing and reading *The Greatest Journey*, the 12 week Bible study that now goes out wherever the boxes are distributed. All of us can have a part in this amazing outreach opportunity.

December 1-8 is our Week of Prayer for International Missions. The theme verse is Revelation 7:9; "I saw a great multitude from every nation and all tribes..." (continued on page 3)

There will be a special business meeting after both services on Sunday, December 1, to vote on the 2020 Budget Proposal. (There will not be a discussion during this meeting.)




We have adopted 6 children, from 4 families in our childcare center.
