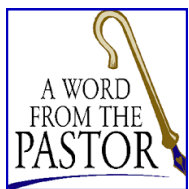

Dear church family,

**G**reetings in the precious name of our Lord, Jesus Christ. November is a busy month for our church. Of course we have Thanksgiving and all preparations for that, but this is also the month we collect the shoe boxes for Operation Christmas Child (November 17<sup>th</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup>). It is also our church's 63<sup>rd</sup> anniversary. We will celebrate on Sunday the 24<sup>th</sup> with a fellowship supper after the second morning service.



There have been a few changes to our fellowship hall since last year. When you look up, you will notice that we have recently upgraded all of the lights with next generation LEDs. Believe it or not, in the six years since we replaced all of the fluorescent tubes with LEDs, the technology has vastly improved. The new LEDs use about a third of the electricity of the "old" ones and give even more light. We were able to purchase them with a

\$13,545 grant from the Energy Savings Program of Delmarva Power.

If you look down, you will notice that the floor is also different. All of the carpet squares are gone. Thanks to the hard work of the local Boy Scouts Troop #131 for an Eagle Scout project, our fellowship hall has literally been transformed. We now have commercial grade linoleum tile across the whole 4,000+ square feet of the hall. What a wonderful new look (and so much easier to take care of it). Our Jesus Loves Me Childcare Center is especially grateful for these and many other improvements in our facility.

What you might not notice, but it too is new since last year, is the heating and air conditioning. We have had to replace two complete heat pump units, not only in the fellowship hall, but upstairs in the offices as well. After more than 25 years in our educational wing, things are finally wearing out. Praise the Lord we have been able to do

all of this work and pay for it as well! While we were doing all of this, we had to replace the aging underground propane tank. We now have two brand new 1,000 gallon, above ground tanks. We received both when we prepaid for 11,800 gallons of propane. We should have enough fuel to heat our church facility for several more years. If all of these improvements are too much for your heart to handle, we now have a defibrillator. We can actually shock someone's heart, if there would ever be such an emergency.

I am so grateful for our Trustees, under the chairmanship of Bob Veasey, for all of these (and many other) necessary upgrades. These things don't just happen. All of you in our church family are a part of this body of Christ. God has gifted each of us, by His Holy Spirit to serve Him. We work together to the praise of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ.

This year marks the 20<sup>th</sup> year that we have been a drop off location. It is such a joy as other groups and individuals bring in their shoe boxes, and together we pray for the children who will be receiving them.

The cartons we pack will be taken to a church in Delaware where they will be shipped to the processing center in Baltimore. From there, they will be shipped all over the world. Some of our church members plan to go to Baltimore to be a part of this process.

If you have any items left over after you have finished packing your boxes, you can donate them by placing them in the box by our Operation Christmas Child display that is located in our education wing. These items will be sent to the processing center where they will be put in the shoe boxes as needed.
