Greetings in the precious name of our Lord Jesus Christ. We have just finished collecting the Christmas shoeboxes for our 27th year. This year our church set a record thanks to all your efforts working together and collecting things throughout the year. We had 246 boxes in hand and another 42 that were done online, for a grand total of 288! Altogether we collected 2339 boxes from all who brought them in during the week.

We are taking a group of volunteers to the Operation Christmas Child Processing center in Baltimore on December 9th to help in that important processing work. If you would like to go along, there are a few slots still available. You will get a free Operation Christmas Child tee shirt! Woo Hoo!

Jesus said, "It is more blessed to give than to receive." That truth is never more evident than at this time of the year. We are doing many different things at Christmas that require all of us working together to make them happen. There are the Angel Tree and Lottie Moon Christmas offering to name a few. Our goal this year is to raise \$2,750.00 for our International missionaries. 100% of this offering goes to get the gospel to the world. The national goal is \$200 million. It represents nearly 2/3 of the International Mission Board's (IMB) total mission budget for the whole year.

Last year your 3,521 International missionaries led 178,177 persons to faith in Christ! 102,417 persons were baptized, 21,231 new churches were started, and 67 new people groups were reached with the gospel! Isn't it great to cooperate with brothers and sisters of like precious faith?!

Lately we have been studying the passages on giving in the book of 2 Corinthians. Paul says that our generosity in the grace of giving is a test of the sincerity of our love (2 Cor. 8:7-8 & 21). Thank you all for your generous and sacrificial giving to the work of the Lord, here and around the world through our missionaries.

Jesus is the One who gave the most loving gift of all. "For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, so that you through his poverty might become rich." "Thanks be to God for his indescribable gift!" (2 Cor. 8:9 & 9:15). We will be praising God throughout eternity for the unbelievable sacrifice of Himself on the cross for our sins! To God be the glory.

I pray that you all have a most joyous Christmas and a blessed New Year.



### For Such A Time As This

### Esther 4:14

I thank God for the times in which we live. And even though there is so much evil in the world, yet I can rejoice and praise GOD and love Him with all my heart, and with all my soul, and with all my mind, and with all my strength for all His uncountable blessings in His world in the 21st Century and upon His people.

We are in the sixth millennium of human history since creation, and that means 60 centuries of Satan's war against God and his people for the very souls of men: whom will you worship? 


